Adverb	Type	Level	Example
slowly	manner	A1	She walks slowly.
quickly	manner	A1	He finished quickly.
carefully	manner	A1	Please drive carefully.
well	manner	A1	She sings well.
badly	manner	A1	He played badly.
quietly	manner	A1	They spoke quietly.
loudly	manner	A1	The baby cried loudly.
happily	manner	A1	The kids played happily.
sadly	manner	A1	Sadly, we lost the game.
easily	manner	A1	You can do it easily.
now	time	A1	Start now.
then	time	A1	We ate then left.

hardly	degree	B1	I can hardly hear you.
mostly	degree	B1	It's mostly sunny.
partly	degree	B1	It's partly cloudy.
exactly	degree	B1	She did exactly that.
roughly	degree	B1	It's roughly ten miles.
probably	degree	B1	It will probably rain.
